Intensity and Value

In the squares below you can see the relationship intensity has with value. At the top the red gradually becomes more neutralized as it moves towards white. The same change occurs from right to left in the lower squares. In the lower examples however the values do not change like they do in the top squares. Remember value and intensity are two different properties of color. Values do sometimes change as you are altering the intensity of a color. You must observe carefully and determine whether the value change is needed given the color you are trying to mix.
