### Value Scale: (1.5" wide x 9" tall)


- -Consistent rate of change from one section to the next
- -Even tones within each section

# **Egg/Sphere Drawing:** (approx. life size or larger)

- -Accurate proportions
- -Clear division of light mass and shadow mass
- -Attention to edge variations
- -Attention to value relationships
- -Attention to zones of light logic

## (Do not smudge values with any type of object/material)

This project is intended to build your ability to understand value relationships, the physics of light, the changes in form as well as strengthen your sensitivity in the use of the material. For this reason, you may **NOT** use a blending stump or chamois to create your values or edge variations. You should build up the values and edges in your drawing by using varying degrees of pressure with your pencils.



Notice nothing in the set up of the egg is pure black. Just because a shadow is created does not always mean that it is extremely dark. It depends on the situation. Remember to compare your values to each other in order to determine their relationship.
